## An update on the Financial Services (Disclosure and Provision of Information) (Jersey) Law 202-.

The Financial Services (Disclosure and Provision of Information) (Jersey) Law 202- is being introduced to deal with FATF recommendations regarding beneficial ownership and is due to come into force together with its related regulations and orders later this year. This legislation makes certain changes to the collection of beneficial ownership and significant persons information by the JFSC in relation to companies, foundations and other entities and determines the additional information which will or may be made public, in particular foundations.

## Does Jersey need a law change on the role environmental, social and governance (ESG) factors can play in trustee investment duties?
