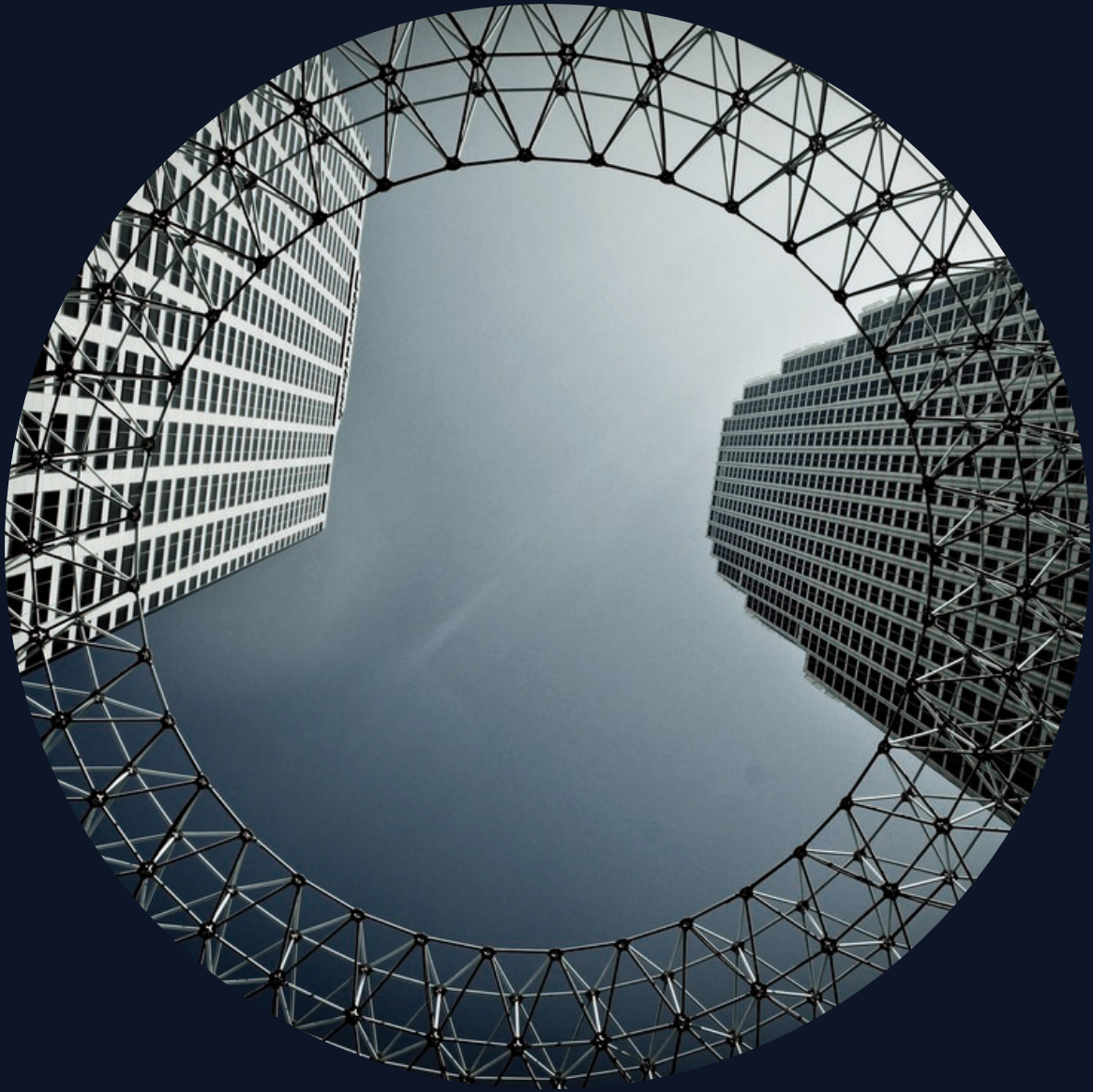

Pioneer Global Assets Tokenized Fund SPC

Ogier acted as Cayman Islands counsel on the establishment of Pioneer Global Assets Tokenized Fund SPC and its first segregated portfolio, Storefront Project T SP, which acts as the issuer of the PRINCE Tokens.
